	Cargoes of a value up to 3000 GEL are subject to payment of customs fees of 150 GEL. Cargoes of a value from 3000 GEL to 15000 GEL are subject to payment of customs fees of 300 GEL. Cargoes of a value more than 15000 GEL are subject to payment of customs fees of 400 GEL.
	All in-bound non-diplomatic shipments are subject to payment of customs VAT of 18% of CIF value Waybill
	- Detailed inventory list (detailed description of each and every item, total number of pieces, customs value for each item, total value for customs purposes, which should correspond with value mentioned on pro-forma invoice)
	- Copy of the passport

Helpful Tips	 Origin of vehicle (technical passport and certificate of title) The consignee's organization mentioned on the waybill MUST be registered in Georgia If there is no detailed inventory list for any shipment then the customs officer is entitled to make intensive inspection and evaluate every item by himself. This process might take from 3 to 10 working days. This might lead to a substantial increase in total amount of customs fees and customs VAT to be paid by the consignee.
